GSAI Program – Growth and Scaling Through AI (2025–2028)

The GSAI program is designed to help startups in the Central Baltic region scale their business through AI applications that enhance or expand their value proposition or business model – enabling growth in their first or next EU market(s).

Over the course of 9 months, starting June 3 (2025), 15 growth-ready startups up to 5 years old, from Sweden, Finland, and Estonia will receive hands-on support from world-leading experts in business development and AI – helping them maintain their competitive edge and accelerate their growth during this crucial stage of building a business. **This is a joint initiative** by Movexum (Sweden), AI Sweden (Sweden), Yrityssalo (Finland) and Tehnopol (Estonia). GSAI is financed by Interreg Central Baltic, providing participants with a comprehensive support package at **no cost.**

Q&A

Who Can Apply?

Startups that meet the following criteria are eligible:

- Start-up is up to **5-7 years**
- Based in the **Central Baltic region** (Sweden*, Finland, Estonia)
- Have achieved **initial product–market fit** in the home market
- Have a hypothesis for at least a **basic Al**augmented product or feature
- Board level commitment to international expansion
- Potential access to customer or application data
- A committed team/co-founders onboard
- Open to international investment opportunities

How Does the Application Work?

Apply by **May 15** by filling in <u>this form</u>. We review all applications and get back to all applicants. A total of **15 startups** – 5 from each country (Sweden, Finland and Estonia) – will be able to participate in the first program batch.

What Does It Cost?

Nothing. GSAI is financed by Interreg Central Baltic, providing participants with a comprehensive package at **no cost.**

How Does the Program Work?

The program begins on June 3 with an online event, "Al 101 – An Introduction". This is followed by four sprints, each designed to provide hands-on support and guidance. **8 workshops** will be held across the Central Baltic region:

- Gävle, Sweden
- Stockholm, Sweden
- Tallinn, Estonia
- Salo Finland

Startups will receive tailored support from business coaches and AI experts during the workshops. Between Sprint 3 and 4, participants can join a Market Discovery Mission (travel and accommodation covered). The program also includes meetings with potential clients and investors.
